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The purpose of this Special Order is to inform members of the department of the new procedures for selection of officials above the rank of sergeant to head District Vice and Gambling Enforcement Units.

General Order No. 307.1, Part IIIA is amended as follows:

"A. District Commanders.

District Commanders shall be responsible for:

1. Vice conditions within the geographic area of their command. They shall work in close cooperation with the Director, Morals Division, and shall discuss vice matters periodically with him/her with a view toward suppressing vice within their particular district.

2. Establishing within their commands a Vice Enforcement Unit which shall be responsible for the enforcement of all vice laws except gambling, and a separate Gambling Enforcement Unit which shall be responsible for the enforcement of all gambling laws. Assignments to these units shall be in accordance with the procedures outlined in General Order No. 201.1 (Non-Uniformed Assignments).

a. Each unit shall be headed by an official who shall report directly to the official designated to head the two units.

b. The Field Operations Officer shall review and approve the number of personnel assigned to each unit.

3. Designating an official of their command (above the rank of sergeant) to head the Vice and Gambling Enforcement Units.

a. Such designation and any subsequent appointment to that position shall be submitted, in writing, to the Chief of Police for final approval.

b. The official so designated shall not be assigned to any other duties and shall work the hours designated by the district commander.

c. The official so designated shall report directly to the district commander.

4. Assigning all vice and gambling complaints to the official in charge of the Vice and Gambling Enforcement Units for investigation.


5. Ensuring that an up-to-date list of all known or suspected places of vice activity within their district is made readily available to all members under their command by the official in charge of the Vice and Gambling Enforcement Units, unless such disclosure might jeopardize an active investigation.

6. Ensuring that a PD Form 68 is prepared in instances where suspects move from one district to another during the course of an investigation.

- a. One copy of the PD Form 68 shall be forwarded to the commander of the district to which the suspect has moved along with all available information on the suspect.
- b. One copy of the PD Form 68 shall be retained in the originating district's Vice Street Address File.

7. Ensuring that all PD Forms 68, reporting vice arrests, are forwarded to the Director, Morals Division, as soon as possible, but not later than the fifth calendar day following the date the arrest occurred."

*This Special Order shall remain in effect until such time as the contents are incorporated into General Order No. 307.1.
