

The Arrest of Offenders Residing in Community Correctional Facilities
(Halfway Houses)
Read at Roll Calls for the next 30 days

In an effort to better track and account for offenders residing in Community Correctional Facilities (Halfway Houses) the D.C. Department of Corrections (DOC) has requested assistance in tracking offenders that are arrested for offenses within the city.

Effective immediately, upon verification that an arrested subject is a resident offender in a DOC Community Correctional Facility, the arresting officers shall print in bold letters across the top of the PD 163, "**Defendant is a Resident Offender**" This will alert the Papering Assistant and the Arraignment Judge of the arrestee's status and the arrestee will be returned to the custody of DOC.

If there are any questions about the residential status of any arrested subject that is suspected of residing in a DOC facility, members can call the DOC on 202-671-2099.
