The purpose of this order is to establish the policy and procedures for maintaining crime maps within each district to assist in the deployment of department resources in combating crime. This order consists of the following part:

PART I Responsibilities and Procedures for Supervisory and Command Personnel

PART I

A. General.

Commanding officers shall maintain at least four separate maps of their respective districts, upon which shall be indicated by location, the following crimes:

1. Map No. 1: Robberies
2. Map No. 2: Burglaries
3. Map No. 3: Larcenies from Autos
4. Map No. 4: Stolen Autos

B. Minimum Requirements.

1. Map numbers 1 through 4 shall be maintained on a weekly basis.
2. Offenses shall be indicated on the appropriate map within 48 hours of occurrence.
3. Each map shall contain in the lower left hand corner a legend indicating the method of marking and meaning of markers utilized on that particular map.


C. District Commanders.

District commanders shall have the authority to:

1. Establish the method of marking maps.
2. Establish and maintain such other maps as they may consider necessary.

3. Vary the required maps so long as the minimum data required is indicated thereon.

4. Establish the procedures for retention or re-use of crime maps within their districts.
