The purpose of this order is to insure that only the proper collateral for traffic violations is accepted. This order consists of the following part:


A. Approved Schedules.

1. Attachment "A" is a schedule of "Collateral for Traffic Violations" established by action of the Board of Judges through the Chief Judge of the Superior Court for the District of Columbia.
2. Attachment "B" is a "Collateral and Mandatory Appearance List for Traffic Offenses Occurring on Military Installations in the District of Columbia" established by action of the United States Magistrates for the United States District Court for the District of Columbia. Citations issued under the authority of this list will be issued by police under military jurisdiction only. The collateral portions are administered by the military, however, all offenders of whom bail is required shall be processed through the Central Cell Block, Identification and Records Division.
3. Attachments "C" and "D" are Collateral and Mandatory Appearance Lists for traffic offenses occurring on Veterans Administration and U.S. Postal Service properties in the District of Columbia, established by action of the United States Magistrates for the United States District Court for the District of Columbia. Citations issued under the authority of these lists will be issued by officers of the Veterans Administration and the U.S. Postal Service only. The collateral portions are administered by the Veterans Administration and U.S. Postal Service, however, all offenders of whom bail is required shall be processed through the Central Cell Block, Identification and Records Division. The Desk Lieutenant, Criminal Investigations Division, is authorized to effect bail releases under this provision.

B. Authority to Alter.

Members ~~of the force~~ shall bear in mind that the attached schedules confer no authority upon any member ~~of the force~~ to alter the collaterals contained therein. In any case where the provisions of these collateral schedules are in conflict with orders previously issued, the provisions of the schedules shall prevail.
