The purpose of this order is to establish the necessary bond and collateral required for cases triable in the U.S. Branch of the District of Columbia Superior Court, and for cases to be presented before the U.S. Magistrates for the United States District Court for the District of Columbia, resulting from incidents occurring on Veterans Administration and U.S. Postal Service properties, and for offenses to be processed under the Code of Federal Regulations Petty Offenses.

PART I Bond and Collateral Schedules to be Followed by Members of the Department

PART I

Approved Bond and Collateral Schedules.

1. At Attachment "A" is the bond schedule, established by the Board of Judges, for cases triable in the U.S. Branch of the District of Columbia Superior Court.
2. Mandatory appearances before the U.S. Magistrates for the United States District Court for the District of Columbia, are required for the offenses identified in Attachments "B" and "C" which occur on the properties of the U.S. Postal Service and the Veterans Administration respectively. In these instances, an offender shall be released for such an appearance upon the posting of bail either in the form of \$100 cash or surety bond. However, if an offender is eligible for release under the citation release program, the Desk Lieutenant, Criminal Investigations Division, is authorized to effect such release after the offender has been processed through the Central Cell Block, Identification and Records Division.
3. At Attachments "D" and "E" are collateral lists, established by the U.S. Magistrates for the United States District Court for the District of Columbia, for which collateral may be forfeited for those offenses occurring on properties of the U.S. Postal Service and the Veterans Administration respectively.
4. At Attachment "F" is the order of the U.S. Magistrates for the District of Columbia which prescribes the required collateral and processing procedures for offenses occurring under the Code of Federal Regulations Petty Offenses.
