DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

Pursuant to the Omnibus Public Safety Agency Reform Amendment Act of 2004, § 1201, the requirement for sworn members to reside within 25 miles of the District of Columbia has been eliminated. Therefore, with the publication of this Special Order, GO-PER-201.14 (Residency Requirements), and Teletype 11-004-03 are hereby rescinded.

Sworn members shall continue to adhere to the following procedures until such procedures are incorporated into the appropriate General Order:

Procedural Guidelines

- A. Sworn members shall maintain an operational telephone at their residence at all times, or be in possession of a cell phone that is used as their permanent telephone.

NOTE: "Telephone" is defined as a permanently installed ("hard-wired") telephone, also known as "landline," or a member's personal cell phone.

- B. Sworn members who reside in an area that does not receive adequate cell phone coverage must have a "hard-wired" telephone at their residence.
- C. Upon permanent assignment to an organizational element, sworn members shall immediately report their correct residential address, telephone number, and marital status to their commanding officer.
- D. Within 24 hours, sworn members shall complete the PD Form 73 (Personnel Action) to report any changes in their residential address, telephone number, and/or marital status, and submit this form to their commanding officer.
