

PD Form 378 (Domestic Violence) has been revised. The Revised PD Form 378, entitled "Domestic Violence" Handout, explains this department's procedures for handling domestic disputes; and it describes the civil and criminal remedies that victims can pursue to curtail violence. Also included in the pamphlet are the names, phone numbers, and brief descriptions of the social service agencies that assist victims with the legal and emotional problems that result from domestic violence.

PD form 378 shall be issued to victims of domestic violence. In addition, **the member shall enter his/her name, badge number, date and complaint number in the space provided on the front of the pamphlet, and check the appropriate block to reflect the district of occurrence.**

The revised PD Form 378 (dated Revised 5/97) is in stock and available through normal supply channels. Effective immediately, all copies of PD Form 378 that are not dated Revised 5/97 shall be removed from stock and destroyed.

Members should be reminded that PD Form 378 will remain on the list of forms required to be kept in vehicles (General Order 301.1, Attachment C).
