I. BACKGROUND

The purpose of this order is to outline the required notifications when a member of the Metropolitan Police Department (MPD) is notified of an incident at the New Beginnings Youth Development Center. The New Beginnings Youth Development Center is a 60-bed, secure facility for committed youth located in Laurel, Maryland. New Beginnings provides twenty-four (24) hour supervision, custody and care including, but not limited to residential, educational, medical, and mental health services.

II. DEFINITIONS

For the purposes of this directive, the following terms shall have the meanings designated:

- 1. Incidents Include, but are not limited to, deaths, criminal assaults requiring off-site medical treatment, and escapes.
- 2. Members Sworn or civilian employees and members of the MPD Reserve Corps.

III. PROCEDURES

A. When notified of an incident at the New Beginnings Youth Development Center, members shall notify an official immediately.

- B. The notified official shall ensure the Watch Commander, Fifth District, and the Watch Commander, Command Information Center (CIC), are notified immediately.
- C. The Watch Commander, Fifth District, shall be responsible for coordinating the initial response for incidents that occur at the New Beginnings Youth Development Center.
 - 1. The Watch Commander, Fifth District, shall ensure that MPD responds to the New Beginnings Youth Development Center for reported:
 - a. Deaths;
 - b. Criminal assaults requiring off-site medical treatment; and
 - c. Escapes.
 - 2. For all other criminal incidents, the Watch Commander, Fifth District, shall determine if a response to New Beginnings is required using his/her discretion.
 - 3. For all responses to New Beginnings, the Watch Commander, Fifth District, shall ensure a PD Form 251 (Incident-Based Event Report) is prepared that specifies the event location as **8400 River Rd, Laurel, MD 20724**.
 - 4. The Fifth District Watch Commander will notify the CIC anytime a unit is dispatched to New Beginnings.
- D. Attachment A to this order provides directions to the New Beginnings Youth Development Center.
- E. The Watch Commander, CIC, shall ensure that each time a unit is dispatched to New Beginnings:
 - 1. The following members are notified immediately of reported incidents at New Beginnings:
 - a. The Field Commander;
 - b. The Assistant Chief, Investigative Services Bureau;
 - c. The Assistant Chief, Patrol Services and School Security Bureau;

- d. The Commander, Fifth District;
- e. The Watch Commander, Criminal Investigations Division; and
- f. The Watch Commander, Youth Investigations Division.
- 2. A summary of the incident is listed on the morning CIC report.
- F. The Commander, Fifth District, shall coordinate with staff at New Beginnings to schedule a monthly pickup for drugs that have been confiscated and need to be destroyed.

Directions from the Fifth District Police Station, Washington, DC, to the New Beginnings Youth Development Center, 8400 River Rd, Laurel, MD 20724

- 1. Head northeast on Bladensburg Road, NE.
- 2. Take the 2nd right onto US-50 E/New York Avenue, NE.
- 3. Take the Baltimore-Washington Parkway exit on the left toward Baltimore.
- 4. Merge onto Baltimore-Washington Parkway (travel for approximately 14 miles).
- 5. Exit onto MD-198 E/Laurel Fort Meade Road toward Fort Meade.
- 6. Turn left onto Old Portland Road.
- 7. Take the 1st right onto River Road.
- 8. The entrance to the New Beginnings Youth Development Center is on the right.
