

Closure of the DC DMV Driver Improvement Office
Read at Roll Calls for the next 30 days

This is to inform you that the DC DMV Driver Improvement Office, now located at 301 C Street, N.W., in room 1033, will permanently close on Friday, January 30, 2009. Drivers and Police Officers will no longer be able to obtain traffic records or resolve DMV issues at 301 C Street, N.W. Adjudication Services, where parking, minor moving violation, and photo enforcement tickets are paid and/or contested at administrative hearings, will continue to be located at 301 C Street, N.W. Drivers with ticket issues must be directed to room 1157 at 301 C Street, N.W.

Effective Monday, February 2, 2009, drivers with traffic record issues, such as suspension, revocation, or reinstatement of driver licenses, must be directed to report to the DMV's Penn Branch Service Center, located at 3220 Pennsylvania Avenue, S.E., Washington, D.C. 20019. The hours are 8:15 am to 4:00 pm Monday through Friday. Drivers who have received DMV form 33-40's (proposed notices of suspension for DUI, DWI, OWI, speeding in excess of 30 mph above the posted speed limit, etc.) and need to schedule a show cause hearing or a reinstatement must be directed to Penn Branch Service Center. The show cause hearings and ticket hearings will continue to be conducted at 301 C Street, N.W. These drivers must report to room 1157 for their hearings.

Police officers and prosecutors must contact the DMV Office of Service Integrity to obtain traffic records and copies of suspension or revocation orders. That office is located at 95 M Street, S.W. The telephone number is 202-729-7021. The Service Integrity Officer is Mr. Gabriel Robinson and his assistant is Ms. Courtney Himbrick. It is strongly suggested that you telephone the office prior to making a visit to the office. Police officers who wish to submit DMV form 33-40's for entry into DMV's database to affect a suspension must mail those forms to DC DMV, Processing Center, 95 M Street, S.W., Washington, D.C. 20024.
