Detention Journal Processing of Persons Arrested by Other Law Enforcement Agencies

General Order 502.05, Part III, C states, in part, that "... a person, who has been arrested by another law enforcement agency, and is determined that the person should be released without charge, the receiving element's Watch Commander shall notify the official in charge of the arresting officer's agency to respond to the scene of the arrest or the booking element. Moreover, the Watch Commander shall authorize the release of the arrested person when the outside agency's official does not respond within thirty-minutes of notification of the detention journal case..."

Note: The thirty-minute response time for some outside agencies, specifically, Metro Transit Police would not be probable, due to their multi-jurisdictional coverage (Maryland, Virginia and the District of Columbia).

Effective immediately, when it is determined that an individual arrested by the Metro Transit Police should be released via the Detention Journal, the Watch Commander shall ensure that station personnel immediately notify the Metro Transit Police Watch Commander via their Communications Division at (202) 962-2121. The Metro Transit Police Watch Commander will then respond or contact the district within 30 minutes to handle the Detention Journal Case.
