TRANSPORTATION OF JUVENILES IN NEED OF MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES

The purpose of this teletype is to make members aware of the **closing of Riverside Psychiatric Hospital**. As of November 27, 2007, The Riverside Psychiatric Hospital of Washington, located at 4460 MacArthur Blvd., NW, stopped taking all patients at their facility. This hospital closure impacts the policies and procedures for members who encounter juveniles who pose a threat or danger to himself/herself or others.

A. Effective immediately, members shall:

1. If the juvenile is (14) years or younger transport him/her to Children's National Medical Center, Emergency Room, located at 111 Michigan Ave., NW, for mental health services.
2. If the juvenile is (15) years or older transport him/her to the Psychiatric Institute of Washington (PIW), located at 4228 Wisconsin Ave., N.W., for mental health services.
3. Under no circumstances shall a juvenile who is violent or uncontrollable be transported to Children's National Medical Center. All violent or uncontrollable juveniles shall be transported to Psychiatric Institute of Washington (PIW), for mental health services.
 - i. In all cases of involuntary commitments, members shall complete a FD 12 (Application for Emergency Detention).
 - ii. Immediately notify the juvenile's parent or guardian.
4. Members requiring assistance shall contact Children's National Medical Center at (202) 884-5000 or the Department of Mental Health Access Helpline at 1-888-793-4357. The Access Helpline is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

This order amends S.O.-03-09 and shall remain in affect until incorporated in to G.O. 308.4.
