Due to the increase in pedestrian related fatalities, members of the Department are reminded to aggressively focus their efforts on the enforcement of both vehicular and pedestrian violations throughout the District of Columbia. This initiative will be effective immediately and will not only involve aggressive enforcement, but will increase the public's awareness of pedestrian safety. One of the primary goals of this initiative is to address the violations of all public conveyance vehicles, such as Metro buses, charter buses, tour buses, limousines, and taxis. Members shall be equally aggressive in enforcing pedestrian violations by addressing those violations that are committed in their presence.

District Commanders shall ensure that each Watch Commander reports the total number of pedestrian violations and the total number of violations written on operators of public conveyance vehicles, to the S.O.C.C., prior to the end of their respective tours of duty.

Additionally, the following procedures shall be followed if a member issues a citation to an operator of a Metro bus:

The issuing member will be responsible for notifying the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority (WMATA) with the circumstances of the infraction, date and time of the violation. The WMATA operator can be reached on 202-962-2121. This notification should be documented on the back of the "A" copy of the Notice of Infraction.
