MEMBERS OF THE FORCE ARE REMINDED THAT THE ALCOHOL BEVERAGE REGULATION ADMINISTRATION (ABRA) ENFORCES ABC REGULATIONS AND HANDLES THE INVESTIGATIVE FUNCTIONS FOR THE ABC BOARD. THEIR COOPERATION AND SUPPORT IS INSTRUMENTAL IN IDENTIFYING PROBLEM ESTABLISHMENTS AND ENSURING COMPLIANCE WITH ABC REGULATIONS, MEMBERS ARE FURTHER REMINDED OF THE PROVISIONS WITHIN GENERAL ORDER 401.R, PART 1, SECTION 2B WHICH STATES IN PART "MEMBERS OF THE FORCE SHALL REPORT VIOLATIONS OF THE ABC REGULATIONS...A PD FORM 251 SHALL BE USED WHEN POLICE ACTION TAKEN INVOLVED AN ARREST FOR THE ABC VIOLATION." FURTHERMORE, A PD 251 SHALL BE PREPARED IN CASES WHERE POLICE ACTION IS TAKEN WITHIN OR NEAR AN ABC LICENSED PREMISE FOR AN ABC VIOLATION OR CRIME THAT CAN BE ATTRIBUTED TO THE ESTABLISHMENT. FOR EXAMPLE; AN EMPLOYEE, PATRON OR OTHER PERSON COMMITS A VIOLATION OF THE ABC REGULATIONS OR COMMITS A CRIME ON OR NEAR THE PREMISES AS A RESULT OF THEIR BEING DRAWN TO OR AFFILIATED WITH THE ABC ESTABLISHMENT. MEMBERS SHALL INDICATE THE REASON THEY BELIEVE THE VIOLATOR WAS AFFILIATED WITH THE PARTICULAR ABC ESTABLISHMENT ON THE PD FORM 251. THE OFFICE OF UNIFIED COMMUNICATIONS SHOULD NOTIFY THE WATCH COMMANDER WHEN THERE ARE CALLS TO A LICENSED PREMISE. UPON COMPLETION OF THE OFFENSE OR INCIDENT REPORT, WATCH COMMANDERS SHALL FAX A COPY OF THE PD FORM 251 TO ABRA PRIOR TO THE CONCLUSION OF THEIR TOUR OF DUTY. THESE REPORTS SHALL BE FAXED TO THE ATTENTION OF MS. DIANE ENGLISH, CONTACT PERSON FOR VERIFICATION, ON (202) 727-4052. MS. ENGLISH'S DIRECT NUMBER IS (202) 442-4441. DISTRICT COMMANDERS SHALL ENSURE THAT THE PD 251 IS FAXED TO ABRA AND THAT A COPY OF THE FAX TRANSMISSION REPORT IS RETAINED. IN ADDITION, NOTIFICATION SHALL BE MADE TO THE SOCC. SOCC PERSONNEL SHALL PUT THE NOTIFICATION IN THE SOCC REPORT NEXT TO CRIME REPORTED.
