The Maurice T. Turner Jr., Institute of Police Science announces the On The Job Training Program (OJT) for 19 recruits. Recruit Class 2005-8 will begin their two-week OJT on March 20, 2006.

**REQUIREMENTS FOR OJT**

1. Recruit officers will wear the Class "B" uniform.
2. Recruit officers will work the evening tour of duty, and will have same days off as their training officer.
3. Recruit officers are to be assigned to patrol work, and not an administrative assignment such as the station, hospital details, min-stations etc... They should be engaged in the types of activities normally done by officers assigned to PSA's; such as handling radio runs, community meetings, Orange Hat walks, etc...
4. In order to preclude future court appearances from interfering with recruit training, recruit officers shall not be designated as arresting officers, except in unavoidable situations.
5. Except in exigent circumstances recruit officers shall not operate department vehicles.
6. Unless necessitated by exigent circumstances, or to complete assignments, recruit officers shall not be required to work for Compensatory Time or Overtime.
7. Recruit officers shall be partnered with MPO's or FTO's.
8. Recruit officers shall be supervised by Patrol District Personnel.
