On September 22, 2008, the Office of the Attorney General issued an order providing for amnesty for charges of an unregistered firearm or ammunition in certain situations. This amnesty expires on Saturday, March 21, 2009, as of 2400 hours (12:00 am).

The information below amends TT#09-067-08 on Firearms Registration, and provides guidance on how members shall respond to incidents involving firearms.

1. If a police officer encounters a person legally transporting a firearm:
 Take no action. A person may transport a firearm in the District of Columbia to or from a lawful recreational firearm-related activity in the District or to or from such activity in another jurisdiction provided that such person whenever in possession of the firearm shall upon demand of any member of the MPD or other bona fide law enforcement officer exhibit proof that he is on his way to or from such activity, and:

- a. If transporting a firearm in a vehicle:
 - i. It must be unloaded, and with neither the firearm nor any ammunition readily accessible or directly accessible from the driver's compartment.
 - ii. If the vehicle does not have a compartment separate from the driver's compartment, the gun must be unloaded, and either the gun or the ammunition contained in a locked container other than the glove compartment or console.
- b. If transporting a firearm in a manner other than a vehicle, it must be unloaded, inside a locked container, and separate from the ammunition.

If the person transporting the weapon is a registered owner of a firearm and a District of Columbia resident they must have the registration certificate in their possession.

A person is only allowed to transport an unregistered firearm between their home, a DC Dealer and the Firearms Registration Section during regular FRS business hours (Monday-Friday 0900 to 1700).

- If a police officer encounters a person on public space carrying any unlicensed firearm:**
The unlawful firearm shall be seized as evidence and the violator arrested.
- If a police officer locates an unregistered firearm in a private residence:**
The unlawful firearm shall be seized as evidence and the violator arrested (if applicable).
- If a police officer locates a registered firearm in a private residence and it is not related to any underlying crime (including violations of the Child Access Provision / criminally negligent storage):**
Take no action.
- If a person asks how to register a firearm:**
The member shall refer the person to the MPD Gun Registration Hotline (202-727-9490), the MPD Firearms Registration Section (300 Indiana Avenue, NW, Room 2169, (202-727-4275)) or the MPD website (www.mpdc.dc.gov/gunregistration) to learn how to start the gun registration process.

The *Firearms Registration General Requirements & Study Guide* was updated in January 2009 and is available on the website. Any publication with a date of 2008 or earlier is out-of-date and should not be used.

The policy of the District of Columbia is that each registrant should keep any firearm in his or her possession unloaded and either disassembled or secured by a trigger lock, gun safe, locked box, or other secure device. Trigger locks can be obtained, free of charge, from the Firearms Registration Section.
