Hospitalized Juveniles – Opportunity to Speak with Counsel and Parental Visitation

It shall be the policy of the Metropolitan Police Department to ensure that juveniles who have been arrested and admitted to the hospital have the opportunity to speak with appointed Counsel. Whenever a juvenile is admitted to the hospital while court is in session, a member of the Juvenile Processing Center shall notify the Court Liaison Division of the hospitalization. The papering officer shall ensure that the United States Attorney's Office (USAO) or the Office of the Attorney General (OAG) is notified of the juvenile's status.

Once Counsel has been appointed, the USAO or the OAG shall provide Court Liaison with the name and BAR number of the appointed Counsel. A member of Court Liaison shall ensure that the officer guarding the juvenile and the Juvenile Processing Center is provided with this information. During the visit with the Defense Counsel, the officer on the guard detail will keep visual contact with the juvenile to prevent escape. The officer when possible shall maintain visual contact in such a way that he/she cannot hear the juvenile's conversation with counsel, if possible. The Attorney's information shall be entered in the Hospital Log Book, located at the Juvenile Processing Center.

If the juvenile's counsel seeks to visit the juvenile in the hospital, the Watch Commander of the guard detail, or the Superintendent of Detectives Watch Commander, shall be immediately notified for authorization.

The parent/guardian or relatives and friends of the juvenile **will not** be given access to the juvenile while he/she is hospitalized. However, a parent/guardian can speak to the juvenile by phone after the attorney-client communication. The Watch Commander or the Commanding Officer of the Youth Investigations Branch, shall be
