**Custodial Interview/Interrogation of Hospitalized Juveniles**

The policy of the Metropolitan Police Department is to electronically record, in their entirety, and to the greatest extent feasible, custodial interviews/interrogations of persons, including juveniles suspected of committing a crime of violence, as that term is defined in D.C. Official Code Section 23-1331(4), and other crimes as determined by the Chief of Police. All custodial interviews/interrogations of juveniles shall be conducted by detectives/investigators. Members who are not detectives or investigators shall request that a detective/investigator be made available when a juvenile is to be interviewed/interrogated. If a detective/investigator is unavailable, the arresting officer shall contact the Superintendent of Detectives Division Watch Commander, who will arrange to have a detective/investigator conduct the custodial interview/interrogation.

In those cases where a juvenile, who has been arrested and admitted to the hospital, the arresting officer shall notify the detective/investigator to respond to the hospital to interview/interrogate the juvenile. Considering that the hospitalized youth may not initially be conscious or in a mental or medical state to provide a statement, the detective/investigator will have until one hour prior to the court hearing to obtain a statement.

Upon being notified of a hospitalized juvenile, the detective/investigator, if necessary shall respond to the Youth Investigations Branch and sign out a tape recorder and cassette for the purposes of the interview. The detective/investigator shall ensure that all of the juvenile's information, if possible, is documented in the Electronic Recording log book at Youth Investigations Branch. The tape recorder and cassette shall be



returned properly back to the Youth Investigations Branch. The detective/investigator shall be reminded that custodial interview/interrogations shall not be conducted unless the juvenile has waived his/her Miranda rights. If the juvenile has not previously been given his/her Miranda rights, the recording shall include the giving of rights to the juvenile and his/her or waiver of those rights, if any. If Miranda rights have been waived, the detective/investigator shall affirm that the juvenile was informed of, and waived those rights. The juvenile shall be recorded in both instances.

Members are reminded to note excited utterances and spontaneous statements made by hospitalized juveniles.

The recording of hospitalized juveniles shall be conducted in accordance with General Order 304.16.
