**METROPOLITAN POLICE DEPARTMENT UNIFORM POLICY**

The purpose of this teletype is to reiterate the policy requiring the wearing of badges and nameplates on outer uniform garments and to clarify certain uniform requirements and standards. (Photos attached)

The "FIRST AMENDMENT ASSEMBLIES ACT OF 2004", TITLE III, "POST-AND-FORFEIT PROCEDURE; DISPLAY OF IDENTIFICATION BY POLICE OFFICERS", Sec.321 requires that "Every member of the Metropolitan Police Department ("MPD"), while in uniform, shall wear or display the nameplate and badge issued by the MPD ...and shall not alter or cover the identifying information or otherwise prevent or hinder a member of the public from reading the information." **Therefore all members in uniform are required to wear their badge and nameplate on all uniform outer garments.**

The following is provided to clarify and reiterate the policy for the wearing of certain uniforms:

- **BDU uniform**
  - Consists of:
    1. Trousers-Brigade Style; long sleeve shirt-Brigade Style; short sleeve shirt-Brigade Style; **8-point soft cap-Brigade Style**; and any approved shoes (see Teletype# 02-016-04).
    2. **Badges and nametags will be displayed.**
  - Authorized for:
    1. Members assigned to PSA patrol duties-rank of Sergeant and below (Blue BDUs);
    2. Focus Mission Team (FMT)- personnel rank of Sergeant and below (Blue BDUs);
    3. CDU – (Blue BDUs with gray subdued CDU patch worn in place of the American Experience patch on the sleeve). CDU BDUs are to be worn only while actually working a CDU detail and are not to be worn while performing patrol duties.
    4. ERT (Black BDUs)

- **Mountain Bike Uniform**
  - Consists of:
    1. Issued bike shirt (long or short sleeve)(not polo shirt), jacket, trousers/shorts, bike helmet, and black footwear.
    2. **Badge and nametag will be displayed on jacket if worn.**
    3. **The blue polo shirt is no longer authorized for wear.**
  - Authorized for: members assigned to Mountain Bike units, while actually working as a Mountain Bike officer.
- **Raid Jackets**
  - **Only authorized for members assigned to non-uniform assignments**
- **Headgear**
  - The 8-point service cap will be worn with Class A&B uniforms. **No other headgear is authorized.**
  - The "blue baseball cap" w/ MPD patch or the 8-point service cap will be worn with the Class C utility uniform. **No other headgear is authorized.**
  - The 8-point soft cap-Brigade Style will be worn with the BDU uniform. No other headgear is authorized.

Members shall refer to GO-PER-110.11, Uniforms and Equipment, and Teletype #02-016-04 for further guidelines and standards.

Deviations from this policy are not authorized for unit level command. All exceptions to this policy require review and approval by the Uniform and equipment Board.
