15. DESCRIPTION OF WANTED PERSON OR MESSAGE

Pursuant to General Order 304.16 "Electronic Recording of Custodial Interrogations," members are reminded that persons arrested for the following offenses are to be presented to a detective so the detective can conduct an electronically recorded interrogation. These offenses are; Murder; Voluntary manslaughter; Aggravated Assault; Robbery, Sexual Abuse in the first, second and third degrees; Assault on a police officer; Act of Terrorism; Arson; Assault with a dangerous weapon; Assault with intent to commit any offense; Assault with intent to kill, Assault with intent to commit first degree sexual abuse, Assault with intent to commit second degree sexual abuse, Assault with intent to commit child sexual abuse; Burglary or attempted burglary; Carjacking; Child Sex Abuse; Cruelty to Children in the first degree; Extortion or blackmail accompanied by threats of violence; Kidnapping; Malicious disfigurement; Manufacture or possession of weapons of mass destruction; Mayhem; Use, dissemination or detonation of a weapon of mass destruction; An attempt or conspiracy to commit any of the foregoing offense as defined by an Act of congress or any state law, if the offense is punishable in prison for more than one year; Theft or attempted Theft of a motor vehicle; Any offense resulting in a traffic fatality; Unauthorized use of a Vehicle.

In addition to the above listed offenses, persons arrested for firearms offenses shall be presented to a detective so the detective can conduct an electronically recorded interrogation. Effective immediately, members shall present all PD 163 or PD 379 forms for all arrests for the above listed offense to a detective for review. The detective shall ensure that an electronically recorded interrogation of the suspect was conducted. The detective reviewing the PD 163 or PD 379 shall affix his/her initials to the bottom right hand corner of the forms. The detective shall bring discrepancies to the attention of the arresting member's Watch Commander and the Superintendent of Detectives Division Watch Commander.
