This teletype is to advise members of their responsibilities when a police officer from another law enforcement agency is either arrested or discharges a firearm within the District of Columbia.

Effective immediately, whenever a member of this department **arrests** a police officer from another law enforcement agency, the arresting officer shall immediately notify the watch commander. That watch commander shall immediately notify the **Internal Affairs Division (IAD)** through the SOCC. The Internal Affairs agent shall be responsible for notifying the arrested member's agency officials.

Additionally, whenever a police officer from another law enforcement agency **discharges his/her firearm** within the District of Columbia, the MPD official first learning of the discharge shall immediately notify the watch commander. The watch commander shall notify the on-call **Force Investigation Team (FIT)** member through the SOCC. A FIT investigator shall respond to the scene to obtain information and monitor the situation. The FIT investigator shall also ensure that the appropriate agency is notified of the firearm discharge.

This teletype shall remain in effect until the contents are incorporated into the appropriate department directive.
