TAXICABS AND PUBLIC VEHICLES FOR HIRE

PURPOSE
 55 DCR 3831, published April 11, 2008, "Taxicabs and Public Vehicles for Hire" outlines the rules governing the implementation of a time and distance taximeter system for the District of Columbia.

TAXIMETER is an instrument or device approved by the D.C. Taxicab Commission, by which the charge to a passenger for hire of a licensed taxicab is automatically calculated, and on which such charge is plainly indicated. No taxicab shall be equipped with more than **ONE** taximeter.

Effective May 1, 2008, licensed taxicabs shall be equipped with a taximeter which allows for calculating the following rates and charges: (1) Flag Drop Rate; (2) Distance Rate; (3) Luggage Charge; (4) Radio Dispatch Charge; (5) Fuel Surcharge; (6) Snow Emergency and (7) Wait Time Charges.

Licensed taxicabs shall be equipped with a taximeter that:

- Is fully electronic;
- Has all access points sealed by a taximeter business license by the Commission to avoid tampering. Tampering with a taximeter, taximeter technology system or the cruiser light is prohibited;
- Has casings made of hard impenetrable plastic or metal;
- Is capable of automatically producing a printed receipt for passengers;
- Is capable of producing a printed report for Commission personnel, which shows total mileage total paid mileage, total trips, total units, and total extras.

TAXICABS AND PUBLIC VEHICLES FOR HIRE, SCHEDULE OF FINES

T237 - Operating without meter \$1000.00, and suspension or revocation of hacker's license

T238 - Operating with non-functional meter, \$1000.00

T239 - Operating a cab with "off-size" wheels or tires, \$1000.00, and suspension or revocation of hacker's license

T240 - Operating a cab with "under" or "over" inflated tires, \$1000.00

T249 - Asking for a Destination, \$25.00

TIRES

A driver shall not place tires or wheels of a different size, or "off-size" tires, on the taxicab without re-inspection and recalibration of the meter. A driver shall not operate a taxicab with tires inflated outside the manufacturer's recommended level, be it "under" or "over inflated."

SNOW EMERGENCY

During snow emergency periods, operators shall prominently display on the back of the front seat of the taxicab, and pointed out to the passenger by the driver, a sign authorized by the Commission. The sign stipulates that the passenger shall pay 125 PERCENT of the applicable regular fare, not including any applicable extra charges or surcharges.
