MPD UNIFORM CHANGES – CLASS A BLOUSE

The purpose of this teletype is to amend G.O. 110.11, Uniforms and Equipment.

SERGEANT STRIPES

Effective, Saturday, October 1, 2005, all Sergeants will be required to wear Sergeant chevrons (3.5" H x 3.75" W) on the sleeves of their Class A blouse. Effective immediately, Sergeants may report to the Equipment and Supplies Branch to obtain a voucher for alterations at Department expense.

SERVICE STRIPES

Effective, Saturday, October 1, 2005, all members will be required to wear gold service stripes on their Class A blouse. Effective immediately, members that currently have blue services stripes on their Class A blouse may report to the Equipment and Supplies Branch to obtain a voucher for alterations at Department expense. Members in need of placement of gold service stripes on their Class A blouse may also report to the Equipment and Supplies Branch to obtain a voucher for alterations at Department expense.

UNIT DESIGNATION PINS

Effective, Saturday, October 1, 2005, all members, at the rank of Captain and below, will be required to wear silver unit designation pins (9/16" H) on the lapel of their Class A blouse. Effective immediately, all members at the rank of Captain and below, assigned to a Patrol Service Area (PSA), may report to the Equipment and Supplies Branch to obtain their unit designation pins. Members assigned to a specialized unit will receive further instructions in a forthcoming teletype.
