DESCRIPTION OF WANTED PERSON OR MESSAGE <p style="text-align: center;">“Lively Standard”</p> <p>The policy of the Metropolitan Police Department requires that prisoners taken into custody be processed in the most reasonable time allowable for the collection of information to positively identify and process the prisoners.</p> <p>The Lively Standard (S0-04-05) states that prisoners will be processed within a four hour time period.</p> <p>All districts and specialized units shall have up to three hours from time of arrest to process lock up cases and transport prisoners to the Central Cellblock (CCB). The CCB will have the balance of the four hours to complete the processing of lock-up cases and ensure that prisoners are delivered to court before the court cut-off time daily.</p> <p>In those instances when the CCB is closed for emergencies, all districts and specialized units shall make all reasonable efforts to ensure prisoners are processed and presented to court within four hours from the time of arrest. A prisoner’s eligibility for release (citation release, post bond or collateral, arrest resulting in detention journals) must be decided within four hours of arrest to ensure compliance with the Lively Standard.</p> <p>The Central Cellblock will monitor the District’s Compliance with the “Lively Standard” and prepare reports of violations.</p>
