INJURED PERSON TO THE HOSPITAL

In reference to Special Order 06-08 (Dated July 31, 2006), accordingly, to ensure that all incidents are properly investigated and that the correct classification is assigned to the case for subsequent follow-up investigation, I have directed that the following response protocol be initiated:

- When radio runs are dispatched for injured person to the hospital incidents, the dispatcher shall assign a **patrol unit, patrol official** and a **district detective** to the assignment;
- Upon arrival it shall be the responsibility of the **patrol official** to ascertain and evaluate the facts and determine the proper classification for the report, that will be prepared by the officer;
- The **classifying official** shall then be responsible for signing the report and personally discussing the report with the District Watch Commander.

If the report is classified as a criminal offense, the detective assigned to respond shall immediately initiate the investigation; to include identifying the injured person; checking all data basis to determine if there are any open warrants or if the person has been reported missing. All of the checks and results shall be entered in WACIIS.

Special Order 06-08 shall be amended to include the aforementioned guidelines; however, additional procedures established in Special Order 06-08 shall be adhered to. *This teletype shall be read at all roll calls for the next two weeks.*
