Optional Sick Leave Program Suspended during PST Initiative

An important aspect of the Patrol Support Team (PST) initiative is to increase police presence in neighborhoods by providing additional police personnel drawn from the various districts and specialized units on a six-week rotational basis. In its effort, the Department also implemented a four (4) day workweek for members detailed to the PST initiative. To further maximize the number of members available for PST deployment, the Department will suspend the Optional Sick Leave program to members detailed to the PST initiative.

This restriction will become effective Sunday, August 31, 2008. Thus, members detailed to the PST initiative that are ill and report sick will be required to personally appear at the Police & Fire Clinic for an examination. Members who report sick on Saturdays shall visit the clinic on the next business day prior to reporting for duty at their assigned elements. A copy of the Clinic Data sheet shall be faxed (727-7756) to the PST office.

PST is built upon the participation of its members. It is anticipated that the provisional change will increase the manpower, improve the effectiveness and continue to ensure the success of the program.
