Medical Waivers For Deviation of the Uniform, Equipment, and Appearance Policies

Commanders, Division Directors, and Watch Commanders are to ensure that proper roll call inspections of all sworn members, including uniform, equipment, and appearance, are conducted at the beginning of each tour of duty by supervisors.

Members claiming a medical waiver from any of the uniform, equipment, and appearance policies, (e.g., the grooming policy for a clean-shaven face for males; the requirement that a ballistic vest be worn on the inside of the uniform shirt), shall have a current medical waiver issued by the Medical Services Section, on file with their assigned element. Members not having a current medical waiver (all waivers issued by the Medical Services Section contain an expiration date) on file shall be required to comply with the uniform, equipment, and appearance policies as contained in General Order 110.11.

Members claiming to have a medical condition necessitating a waiver of these policies shall be directed to prepare a PD Form 42 (Report of Injury/Illness) and directed to report to the Medical Services Section. Members seeking a waiver shall provide the PFC provider with all requested information to make a proper determination of the case.
