The Court Services and Offender Supervision Agency (CSOSA), uses Global Positioning Satellite System (GPS) Tracking Equipment in order to monitor a violator's condition of release, to include parole/probation/supervised release. Tampering with, destroying, or failure to comply with the proper handling of these systems by the offenders would constitute a violation of their parole/probation/supervised release and subject them possible revocation.

Members of the Department who come in contact with individuals who are required to wear a GPS monitoring device and who have attempted to tamper with, disable, remove, or mask the transmitter's signal, shall prepare a "Miscellaneous" incident report on a PD 251 and document the incident to include; the individual's name, PDID number, location, date and time.

Members preparing reports (PD 251 and/or PD 252) for the tampering with, masking, or attempted disabling of Court Ordered Offender GPS tracking systems, shall also ensure that a signed copy of the report is forwarded to the Office of the Associate Director for Community Services, Court Services and Offender Supervision Agency (CSOSA) by FAX on 202-585-7374. Their office can also be reached on 202-585-7224. The Court Services and Offender Supervision Agency (CSOSA) shall then take the appropriate action for the violation committed.
