**GUNSTAT**

GunStat is a collaboration involving the Metropolitan Police Department (MPD), D.C. Superior Court, Office of the U.S. Attorney, Court Services and Offender Supervision Agency (CSOSA), D.C. Pre-Trial Services, and Office of the Attorney General. It is established to track gun offenders through the criminal justice system for the purpose of identifying trends, strengths, and weaknesses in all phases of the process.

The criteria by which individuals will be identified for GunStat monitoring are:

1. Individuals who have used a firearm in the commission of a "crime of violence" as defined in DC Code Title 22-1331(4); and/or
2. Individuals who have been arrested more than one (1) time, "repeat offenders" with illegal firearms or ammunition in their possession.

When members conduct WALES/NCIC checks on individuals stopped pursuant to **traffic stops**, or after detaining individuals based upon "**reasonable suspicion**," they shall be notified as to the GunStat connection by either the dispatcher, or the MDC system return. Individuals who have been flagged as GunStat candidates, shall have the phrase "GunStat" appear on the left hand side of the screen under "ID Comments."

Under circumstances where the stop is not the result of an arrest situation; the member shall conduct a protective pat down of the individual for officer safety and/or conduct a cursory search of the area where the subject was observed, looking for the presence of firearm(s). When an arrest is made for a firearm related offense, the term "GunStat" shall be noted on the PD Form 163/PD Form 379 (Adult and Juvenile Arrest Reports [respectively]) and in CJIS at the time of booking. Under conditions where an arrest is not made, members shall follow existing MPD policies and procedures, including the preparation of the PD Form 251 (Event Report) - "Stop and Frisk" (Incident Report).
