Effective immediately, and subject to the exceptions described herein, the following changes to MPD uniform policy are in effect in order to increase our visibility to the public that we serve:

Members are not permitted to wear dark blue BDU shirts with dark blue BDU trousers, except in limited circumstances when approved by the Chief of Police. These instances will be outlined via Teletype.

Modified "Class B" Uniform Authorization

Instead, officers, sergeants, and detectives are authorized to wear the light blue Class-B shirt with the dark blue BDU trousers (Brigade style # BRT) or with the dark blue Class-A trousers. When wearing the long-sleeved Class-B light blue shirt, members are required to wear an authorized uniform neck-tie or turtleneck, as outlined in General Order 110.11.

Additionally, lieutenants and higher ranks are authorized to wear the white Class-B shirt with the dark blue BDU trousers (Brigade style # BRT) or with the dark blue Class-A trousers. When wearing the long-sleeved Class-B white shirt, members are required to wear an authorized uniform neck-tie or turtleneck, as outlined in General Order 110.11.

Members are no longer permitted to wear the dark blue, soft, BDU cap, except on details as outlined above. Instead, when they wear a uniform hat, it shall be the dark blue, eight-point uniform hat. Members are not permitted to wear BDU trousers with their service blouse.
