**Background**

GO-PCS-701.03 "Handling Assaults on Police Officers" states, in part, "...assault on a police officer is extremely serious in nature and has the potential for high media exposure. To ensure that these incidents are handled in a uniform manner and investigated properly, MPD has established uniform procedures to be followed by members of the department."

**Amended Procedures**

Members shall make the following pen and ink **addition to** GO-PCA-701.03 (Handling Assaults on Police Officers), effective date December 29, 2003:

GO-PCS-701.03 (Handling Assaults on Police Officers) Part III. Procedural Guidelines (page 4) add the following sections:

- J. In addition to the provisions of Section A (above), members shall immediately notify an official the rank of sergeant or above when receiving information of any threat against a police officer or police officers and/or all officer safety concerns. The notified official shall then immediately notify the Homeland Security Bureau, Intelligence Fusion Division, Synchronized Operations Command Center (HSB IFD SOCC) to report:

K. The HSB IFD SOCC shall be responsible for making the following notifications upon confirmation of an assault against, or threats to any police officer(s), and potentially serious officer safety concerns:

1. Initial page notifications:
  - a. Chief of Police Command Staff paging group; and
  - b. Investigative Services Bureau, Office of the Superintendent of Detectives, MPD Intelligence Branch paging group (information only).
2. Initial land-line notifications via the FBI Washington Field Office duty desk, (202) 278-2000:
  - a. The Joint Terrorism Task Force (JTTF) Federal Duty Desk officer, Washington Field Office;
  - b. The Supervisory Special Agent in Charge of the National Capital Response Squad, FBI Washington Field Office; and
  - c. Updated notifications to the FBI.

The content of this teletype supersedes any previous directives and will remain in effect until incorporated into all appropriate general orders.
