Language change to General Order 201.17, Part VI, K,3, which states, "Members engaged in police-related outside employment shall, at the beginning of each period of such employment, telephone a supervisor at the Public Safety Communications Center and give him or her the following information:

- a. The member's name;
- b. The location where the member is working;
- c. The name of the employer or supervisor; and
- d. The hours of employment for that day. [SA DCMRs 304.2(a)-(d11)]

Effective immediately all members engaged in police related outside employment shall notify the dispatcher by going into service over their police radio at the start of their outside employment hours. In addition, at the beginning of each period of such employment, members shall notify the SOCC and provide the above listed information.

Members and supervisors are also reminded that they should comply with General Order 201.21, Part VA, which mandates,

"Each member shall:

- 5. Submit a projected schedule of outside employment and overtime hours to his/her official on Sunday prior to the week in which the schedule will be in effect."

This teletype shall remain in effect until incorporated in General Order 201.17 (Outside Employment).
