Revision to Procedures for Handling Subjects on Parole/Probation/Supervised Released Who have Tampered with, Destroyed, or Failed to Comply with the Global Positioning Satellite System (GPS) Tracking Equipment.

The Court Services and Offender Supervision Agency (CSOSA) and Pre-Trial Services, use Global Positioning Satellite System (GPS) Tracking Equipment in order to monitor a violator's condition of release, to include parole/probation/supervised release. Recently, it has come to the Department's attention that members are coming in contact with offenders designated for GPS monitoring who have attempted to tamper with, disable, remove, or mask the transmitter's signal (example: wrapping in foil). Tampering with, destroying, or failure to comply with the proper handling of these systems by the offenders would constitute a violation of their parole/probation/supervised release. This violation subjects them to possible revocation of their release and constitutes Contempt of Court.

Members of the Department who come in contact with individuals who are required to wear a GPS monitoring device and who have attempted to tamper with, disable, remove, or mask the transmitter's signal, shall first confirm that the individual is under supervision by Pretrial Services or Probation (DC only) - check via JUSTIS system and/or CIC. If it is confirmed then said individual is subject to arrest for "Contempt of Court" (United States Attorney Office charge). If the subject is under VA or Maryland supervision the individual is **NOT** Subject to arrest.

The member shall prepare the necessary arrest paperwork, and prepare a "Offense" report for Contempt of Court on a PD 251 and PD 252: documenting the incident to include; the individual's name, PDID number, location, date, and time.

They shall also ensure that a signed copy of the report is forwarded to the Office of the Associate Director for Community Services, Court Services and Offender Supervision Agency (CSOSA) by FAX on 202-585-7374, or to the Director Of DC Pretrial Service by FAX on 202-220-5618.

These procedures shall remain in effect until incorporated into a General Order, rescinded, or revised.
