MEMBERS ARE REMINDED THAT GENERAL ORDER 701.5 INTRAFAMILY OFFENSES, REQUIRES THAT PRIOR TO RESPONDING TO THE INTAKE SECTION OF THE U.S. ATTORNEY'S OFFICE, THEY ARE TO CHECK WITH THE INTRA FAMILY BRANCH OF THE FAMILY DIVISION, D.C. SUPERIOR COURT, TO ASCERTAIN WHETHER THE COMPLAINANT HAS A TEMPORARY PROTECTION ORDER (TPO) OR A CIVIL PROTECTION ORDER (CPO) AGAINST THE DEFENDANT.

UNLESS OTHERWISE INSTRUCTED, IN DOMESTIC VIOLENCE CASES MEMBERS ARE TO REPORT TO THE INTAKE SECTION, U.S. ATTORNEY'S OFFICE, AT 1:00 A.M.

IN ADDITION TO THE PROCEDURES OUTLINED IN GENERAL ORDER 702.1, ARREST AND BENCH WARRANTS, THE CHIEF OF POLICE HAS APPROVED THE BELOW PROCEDURES IN PREPARING AND PROCESSING WARRANT APPLICATIONS RELATED TO A DOMESTIC VIOLENCE CASE.

1. WHENEVER A DOMESTIC VIOLENCE VICTIM DOES NOT WANT TO PROSECUTE, THIS INFORMATION WILL BE REPORTED IN THE BODY OF THE WARRANT APPLICATION.
2. WHENEVER THE DEFENDANT HAS NO "PDID" NUMBER, THIS INFORMATION IS TO BE INCLUDED IN THE "PDID" SECTION OF THE WARRANT APPLICATION.
3. WHEN APPLYING FOR A WARRANT, MEMBERS ARE TO OBTAIN THE DEFENDANT'S RECORD THROUGH WALKS AND TAKE THE COMPUTER PRINTOUT WITH THEM TO THE U.S. ATTORNEY'S OFFICE.
4. WARRANT APPLICATIONS ARE TO BE PRESENTED TO THE U.S. ATTORNEY'S OFFICE PROMPTLY AFTER THE DATE OF THE OFFENSE AND NOT HELD UNTIL A LATER DATE.

THE ABOVE INFORMATION IS TO BE READ AT ROLL CALL FOR THE NEXT THREE DAYS.
